Driver Education Schedule for 2017-2018

In order to receive an ODOT Certification Card, students are required to have a minimum of 30 hours classroom instruction, 6 hours of behind-the-wheel driving, 6 hours of observation and 5 hours of home practice time. **Students (under 18 years) who successfully complete this approved teen driver education program will not have to take their drive test at the DMV!**

Tuition is \$325.00 (classroom materials are included). *A \$50 deposit is required at the time of registration; balance is due prior to starting class.*

Please Note: *The driver education program is a State subsidized program, and is only funded for students with permits and not for licensed drivers. If a student has a license, obtains their license while taking the class, is 18 or older before completing the class, an additional \$200 will be charged. Driver education is a part of the process for obtaining a provisional license. 18 year olds do not have a provisional license. That is why the State does not cover students 18 years of age. In addition, the DMV does not waive the drive test for these students. A Certification of Completion will be issued, but the DMV drive test will not be waived.*

There is a \$75 discount for students that qualify for the Free/Reduced lunch program or Oregon SNAP/TANF benefits. Applicants must provide a letter from Canby School District Nutritional Services (or SNAP/TANF) verifying benefits in order to qualify for the subsidy program (at time of registration). In an effort to ensure the success of your student in this program, **please plan to attend the ODOT required parent/student orientation.** Expectations, objectives and procedures will be reviewed. It is also a time to gain clarification regarding new laws and driving techniques. These sessions will be from 6:00-7:00pm on the student's first night of class.

The Oregon Department of Transportation requires students have a minimum number of classroom instruction hours prior to their first behind-the-wheel drive. **Therefore, drive times start the third week of each session.** No classes are held on legal holidays and behind-the-wheel driving sessions are subject to change on legal holidays. Classes and driving will be held on grading, in-service, and conference days.
