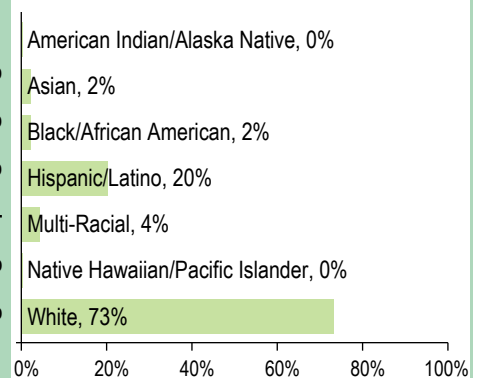

Percent of students with all required vaccines: 93 (Visit www.healthoregon.org/immdata for more information.)

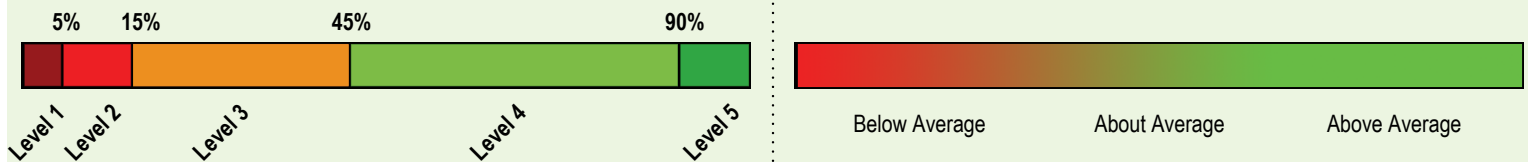
