

Canby School District Driver Education Course Information:

Congratulations for your interest in safe driving! The following should help you understand the program for both classroom and behind-the-wheel drivers education in Canby.

Classes are held at Canby High School.

All classroom sessions are held at CHS's Fourth Street Building/Career Center-Room 1, located at 721 SW Fourth Avenue.

Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis, to the Canby Community Education Office located at 350 SE 13th Avenue. At least \$50.00 of the tuition must be paid to reserve a spot in the class, with the tuition balance and book fee paid in full before the session begins. There is a \$25.00 fee for cancelling less than 48 hours of the class beginning. No refunds after the first class.

To participate you **must have a valid permit or driver's license** and bring it with you each day you drive. We need at least two students to sign up for each driving time. If this does not happen, we will need to reschedule you for the next session or for another time within the same session.

The cost is \$285.00 for instructional tuition plus \$15.00 for required classroom materials. Make checks payable to: Canby Community Education.

Due to legislative changes in Drivers' Education funding, students 18 and over are assessed an additional \$150. Additionally, any student who has or gets their license prior to completing the course will have to pay an additional \$150 fee.

At the beginning and end of the course the instructor will check your permit for compliance.

Drivers Education cars will not wait for tardy students. Be on time to avoid a makeup charge.

Attendance at all driving and classroom sessions is required. In the event of sickness or emergency, give as much advance notice as possible. Make up driving times will be billed at \$40 per hour. Missed classroom time will require make-up arranged through the instructor. Classes will be held on all scheduled days except recognized holidays.

An ODOT required Parent/Student Orientation session will be held from 6:00-7:00pm on the student's first night of class.

Driving a car (and thus Behind-the-Wheel Driver Education) is a risk-taking activity. Students and parents should understand this and know that the purpose of this program is to teach participants to minimize this risk.

At least **five hours** of supervised home practice must be submitted to the instructor before completion of the course.



Your behavior in either the classroom or car is expected to be appropriately responsible and respectful of the subject matter and instructor. If at any point this does not occur, you may be expelled from the program with no refund.

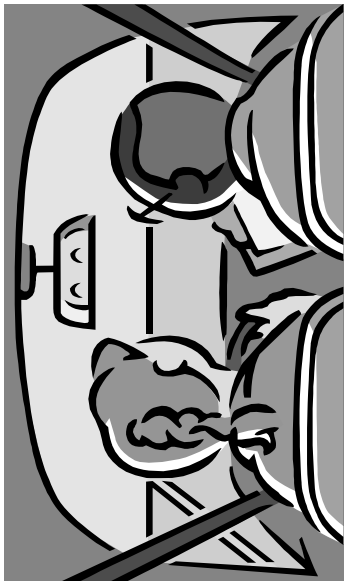
Certification of your driver education course work will occur when you have successfully completed all requirements—both in the classroom and behind the wheel.

You may wish to send a copy to your insurance company as most offer a reduction in premiums for this certification.

The DMV cannot issue an original driver license to anyone under the age of 18 years of age unless the person:

- Has held an Oregon instruction permit for at least six months and
- Certifies with parental verification that the teen has at least 50 hours of supervised driving experience, and
- Completes an ODOT approved traffic safety education course OR certify an additional 50 hours of driving experience as described above.

Oregonians under 18 years of age who apply for their first driving privileges will need to show proof of school attendance, completion of school, or exemption from attendance before DMV will issue them a permit or a driver license. Proof of attendance or completion would include a Statement of Enrollment form (available through the local school district or ESD), a diploma, or a GED certificate. If a person is home schooled or exempt from school attendance, he or she needs to obtain the form through the school district or ESD.

**Once you get your provisional driver license, driving is restricted as follows:**

**First Six Months:**

1. You may not drive with a passenger under age 20 who is not a member of your immediate family\*; and
2. You can not drive between midnight and 5:00am unless you are:
  - Driving between home and work
  - Driving between home and a school event for which there is no other transportation available
  - Driving for employment purposes; or
  - Accompanied by a licensed driver who is at least 25 years old.

**Second Six Months:**

1. You can not drive with more than three (3) passengers who are under age 20 who are not members of your immediate family\*; and
2. You can not drive between midnight and 5:00am unless you are:
  - Driving between home and work
  - Driving between home and a school event for which there is no other transportation available
  - Driving for employment purposes; or
  - Accompanied by a licensed driver who is at least 25 years old.

*\*Passenger restrictions do not apply while driving with an instructor as part of a certified traffic safety education course or with a parent, step-parent, or legal guardian who has valid driving privileges.*

**Note:** The passenger and night driving restrictions only apply until you are 18 or you have had your provisional license for one year; whichever comes first.
