*During the 2018-19 school year, any student who qualifies for reduced meal benefits will receive their meals at no cost. The Oregon Legislature provided funding to cover the reduced price payment for the School Breakfast and the National School Lunch Programs.

Any students attending Ackerman School will pay the meal prices based on their grade level.

Effective July 1, 2011 section 205 of the Healthy, Hunger Free Kids Act of 2010 (Public Law 111-296) requires school food authorities (SFAs) participating in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) to ensure that schools are providing the same level of support for lunches served to students who are not eligible for free or reduced price lunches (i.e., paid lunches) as they are for lunches served to students eligible for free lunches. Therefore, paid meal prices increase yearly to align with this legislation.
